

Barton to Speak at CAMS 2010 Conference

Mark Barton, Director of Computer Services at Rich Mountain Community College, will be a featured speaker in St. Louis at the CAMS 2010 Users Conference June 21-24. CAMS Enterprise is a web based server system which was selected by RMCC to replace an older mainframe style technology in 2003. The portability of the CAMS Enterprise platform was instrumental in the recovery efforts after the April 9, 2009 tornado in Mena.

Barton's presentation "It Can't Happen Here, Can It?" will explain the steps RMCC took to protect critical data and how the College was able to provide almost immediate access to data following the tornado. A second presentation by Barton at the conference will highlight how RMCC is integrating other packages into CAMS (bookstore, student ID cards system, wireless and network access, etc.) CAMS highlights speakers at the conference to give attendees real-world perspectives on the use the software product in various organizations.
