

ETS Students Tour College Campuses



RMCC's Educational Talent Search (ETS) Program recently sponsored a three day tour of colleges and universities in central and northwest Arkansas for participants of the program who are entering their senior year of high school.

Educational Talent Search (ETS) is one of four TRIO programs at Rich Mountain Community College. ETS prepares students in 6 –12 grades for post secondary education following high school graduation.

The 39 rising seniors on the tour represented eight school districts from Scott, Polk, and Montgomery counties. While on the trip the students visited eight different college campuses and participated in various social and team-building activities. The students were accompanied by RMCC's TRIO Secondary Programs Director Brenda Miner and RMCC's ETS representatives Brandon Burk, Erika Smith and Julie Ulmer.
