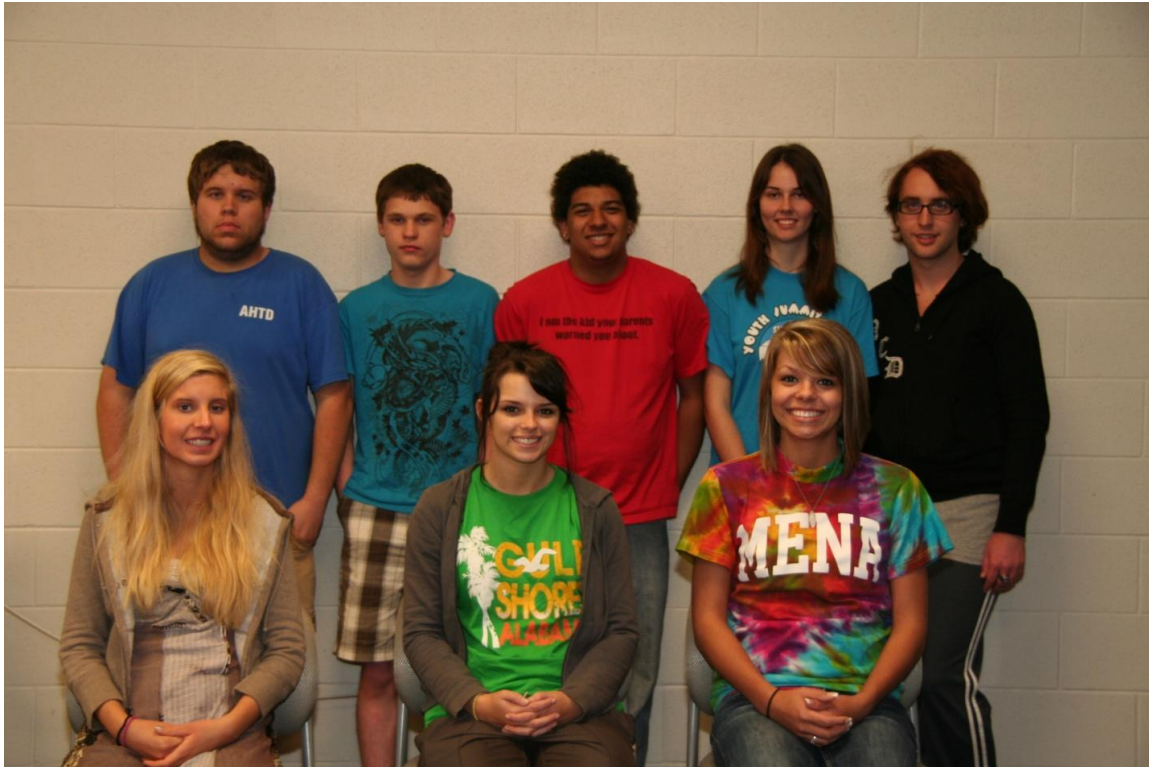


RMCC Students Participate in SkillsUSA State Competition

SkillsUSA is a national organization serving teachers and high school and college students who are preparing for careers in technical, skilled and service occupations. The SkillsUSA Competition is the showcase for the best career and technical students in each state. The first place team in each category can go on to compete in the National Championships in Kansas City.
