

Twister Quilt Workshop

Quilting instructor Stephanie Povey will be conducting an all day “*Twister Quilt Workshop*” on **Thursday, June 16th from 9:00 am to 5:00 PM.**

Bring a lunch and make a twister table topper. Supplies needed for the class include 3 dozen 5x5" fabric squares in lights and darks (half & half); a half yard of dark fabric; a 3 1/2" square of template plastic (can be purchased for \$1 from instructor), fine or medium tip permanent marker, mechanical pencil or box of colored pencils, scissors, sewing machine, 1/4 inch foot, Stitch in Ditch or edge joining foot, darning foot, thread, 1 yard of thin cotton or poly cotton batting, 1 yard cotton backing fabric, 1/2 yard fabric for binding, spray starch, hand needles & thimble, rotary mat, ruler & cutter. If you need any of the feet listed above, they can be available for purchase, but you must register in advance & list your sewing machine make & model so the correct feet will be on hand. Twister quilts are fun and easy, and like eating peanuts, you won't be able to stop with one. With the technique you learn in class, you can easily make a larger quilt at home.
